New Model for our School

You may have heard that Mercy Health decided to close our health center at the end of last school year. However, they reached out to our school in June to see if we would consider partnering with them to operate our health center under a different model. Our LSDMC made the decision to partner with them and implement the Mercy Care and Education program. This means, we will have a nurse practitioner on-site 2 days a week and the other days we will have RN on-site to care for our students, staff and families. When the nurse is on-site, they can consult with the nurse practitioner to evaluate concerns or needs identified during clinical assessments. Mercy will also be launching telehealth services in the spring allowing our families easier access to healthcare. In addition, the

Washington School has partnered with Beechacres for over 10 years and we are very excited about this change. Not only will they be continuing to provide behavioral health, crisis support, family engagement and parent education programming, they will be reaching out to all of our families to find out family's needs and interests. Their goal is to help increase parent involvement and to make sure families are aware of all the services available at Mt. Washington School. This was a pilot project that was implemented at Saylor Park Elementary last school year and it proved to be extremely successful in connecting families to services and getting more parents involved in school. 75% of the Saylor Park families participated in a family or parent engagement activity last year as a result of this project! We hope to see that amount of engagement from our families this year!

Walnut Hills High School Shadowing Opportunities

This is a reminder that registration for the Walnut Hills High School shadow program will open on the Walnut Hills' website on October 1st. Shadowing takes place Monday through Thursday on school days in all weeks of November, the last three weeks of January, all weeks in February and the first week of March. There will be approximately 370 openings, but past experience has proven that they may fill by mid-day on October 1st.
